

General Regulations for Degrees in the Faculty of Social Sciences

- 1.(a) A candidate following a professionally validated and prescribed programme must pass all units mandatory for the purpose of professional accreditation in order to be eligible for the award of the degree. This applies to the following programmes within the Faculty,

- 1.(b) Where a candidate would have satisfied the Examiners in respect of a unit but for a failure in one or more components of that unit mandatory for the purpose of professional accreditation, the Examiners may recommend that the candidate be required to re-sit only in respect of that component or those components. Where the candidate satisfies the Examiners in the re-sit examination, the grade for the unit shall be determined as if a bare pass had been awarded in respect of that component or those components.
