During this period a candidate shall take courses deemed to be the equivalent of Level 2 units to the value of *one hundred and twenty* credits.

5. A candidate may spend the second session as a full-time student at an overseas university, the arrangements being subject to the approval of the Head of Department. During this period a candidate shall take courses deemed to be the equivalent of F5 Level units to the value of *one hundred and twenty* credits.
6. On completion of Level 2, a candidate may be permitted by the Faculty to become instead a candidate for the Degree of BA in Urban Studies (TRPU103).
7. A candidate shall attend one or more fieldwork courses, the arrangements being subject to the approval of the Head of Department.

8. A candidate shall acquire work experience in an office of a local planning authority or other office as approved by the Head of Department for a minimum period of two weeks during the summer vacation preceding the third session and for a minimum period of two weeks during the Easter vacation of the third session.
9. On completion of Level 3, a candidate may be permitted by the Faculty to become instead a candidate for the Degree of BA in Urban Studies and Planning (TRPU104).
10. Before proceeding to Level 4, a candidate for the Degree of MPlan in Urban Studies and Planning must achieve a weighted mean grade of 49.5 at Level 3. A candidate who fails to satisfy this requirement may be awarded the Degree of BA Urban Studies and Planning (TRPU104).
11. A candidate must achieve a mean grade of not less than 49.5 in order to be eligible for the award of the Degree of MPlan in Urban Studies and Planning. A candidate who fails to satisfy this requirement may be awarded the Degree of BA Urban Studies and Planning (TRPU104).
